Game Changers

Game Changers provide the kind of support that can have life-changing impact on young people, such as:



GAME CHANGER (\$100K+)

- Tutors for STEM and life skills curriculum, trauma training, and mental health awareness training for one NJTL chapter
- Fees for a “staff exchange” program within the NJTL network for 20 NJTL chapters to build organizational capacity
- Support for the annual USTA Foundation Impact Conference that brings together the NJTL network for connection, professional development and capacity building

Champion Makers

Champion Makers make a difference in the daily life of a young person to get them ready for the future, such as:



CHAMPION MAKER (\$25K+)

- Updated tennis equipment (racquets, shoes, clothing, tennis bags, racquet stringing, etc.) for 25 NJTL students
- Tournament costs for five Excellence Program students
- Renovation of one tennis court for one NJTL chapter
- College and career-readiness lessons and support for 25 NJTL students

Dream Servers

Dream Servers give young people the tools they need to dream bigger and imagine a brighter future for themselves, such as:



DREAM SERVER (\$1.5K+)

- Internet access for up to 30 NJTL students and families for one month
- Up to two laptops for one NJTL chapter
- School supplies for up to eight students in one NJTL chapter
- Sending one NJTL student to a tennis championship
